The San Luis Valley Counties are considering hiring an intervenor for the upcoming miscellaneous docket that the PUC is opening on or after December 2, 2022. The Valley would like the PUC to consider the need for a redundant line into the Valley and we are looking to form a regional group/voice to join the PUC process in an official capacity to advocate for that need. It was recommended that having an intervenor, with standing before the PUC, was the most effective.
